





Cintro Insecticidal Soap provides effective control of a wide range of pests, including aphids, thrips, whiteflies, leafhoppers, spider mites, and other labeled pests. This easy-to-apply soap works upon direct contact to the insect and leaves no residual insecticidal activity once it has dried.

Cintro works by dissolving the exterior cuticle of the insect, and disrupts the cell membrane, resulting in insect death. Because of its lack of residual activity resulting in minimal impact of beneficial organisms, Cintro integrates seamlessly into IPM programs.

WHERE TO USE

SHELF LIFE

- + Unopened, up to two years under proper storage conditions - in a cool, dry area
- + Opened, up to one year under proper storage conditions - in a cool, dry area
- + Storage: To maintain Cintro's effectiveness, store away from extreme temperatures

APPLICATION NOTES

- + Apply Cintro preventively every 7-14 days or at first sign of pests
- + Best results occur when used at infestation onset
- + Reapply every 7-14 days based on pest pressure and conditions

- + Limit to 3 consecutive applications based on pest pressure and conditions
- + Avoid use during abiotic stress (e.g. drought, heat, nutrient deficiency)
- + Do not store tank mixes longer than 24 hours before use

APPLICATION RATES

- + Foliar spray rates range from 1% (1 gallon) to 2% (2 gallons) per 100 gallons of water, depending on target insect or crop. See label for complete information on application rates.
- + Cutting Dips: Mix a 0.5% solution (3 fl. oz. in 5 gallons water). Do not use without determining crop sensitivity (phytotoxicity) first. Use a clean dipping tank and equipment. Stir solution thoroughly.
