

Increase of Calcium in cherry leaf tissue with Stemmer



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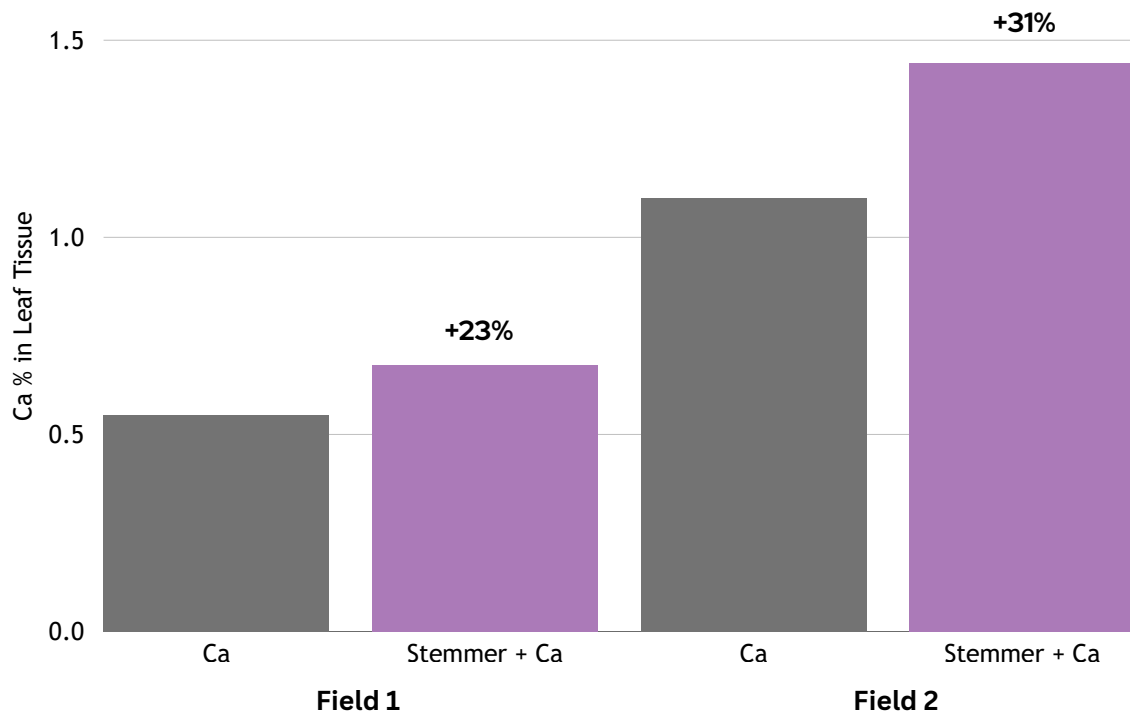

Summary

Stemmer increased the calcium content in leaf tissue by 23% and 31% in two separate field trials and had improvements in both leaf structure and fruit quality. Cherries had more uniform color and were reported more firm by the grower in the Stemmer treated fields.

Method Summary	
Crop	Brooks variety cherry
Location	Visalia, California Hanford, California
Application Method	Foliar Spray
Application Interval	Twice during the season, once after fruit set and again one month prior to harvest.
Application Rate	• 1 qt/acre calcium nitrate • 1 qt/acre calcium gluconate • 1 qt/acre calcium nitrate + 12 oz/acre Stemmer • 1 qt/acre calcium gluconate + 12 oz/acre Stemmer



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
